Our New Jersey customers often ask us why they can't buy beer and wine in their Whole Foods Market®. The answer is that any person or company may hold only two licenses in the State of New Jersey, no matter how many stores they own. This rule dates back to the time following prohibition, when there were very different circumstances than there are today.

There is currently a measure in the New Jersey legislature S-1691/A-2892, which would remove the two-license limit on plenary retail distribution license holders, also known as package goods licenses. We are asking our customers to write or call their senator and assemblywoman or assemblyman to urge the passage of this measure. Please see the handouts below for the suggested text of the letter and for the appropriate elected officials in your district. Your elected officials will act on what they hear their constituents saying!
